3. Christ delivers us from going to Sunday school and church every Sunday.

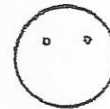
4. Christ delivers us from the Holy Spirit's POWER.



5. Christ delivers us from the POWER that leads us to steal, lie, cheat and hate and fight.



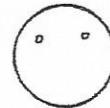
6. Christ delivers us from the POWER that leads us to do the right thing all of the time.



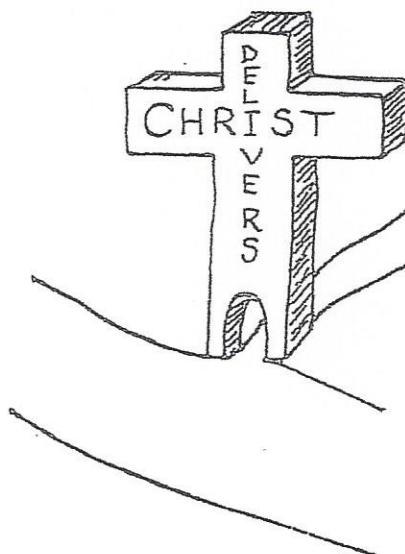
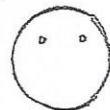
