
TRIALS, TESTING AND TEMPTATION

A Way to Escape – When some of God’s children feel that they are trapped by Satan to do some kind of sin, they should remember God’s promise in I Corinthians 10:13. He promised to make a way for them to escape. A part of the verse says this:


“...God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able; but with the temptation will also make the way of escape that you may be able to bear it.” (NKJV)
