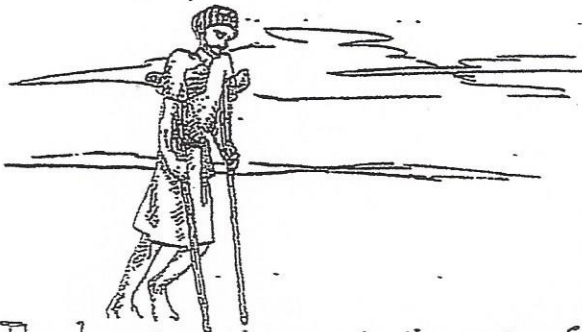


ACTS 3:1-11

Lame Man Walks

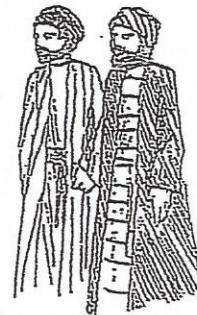
Grades 1-6

The man walked and leaped and praised God. (3:8)



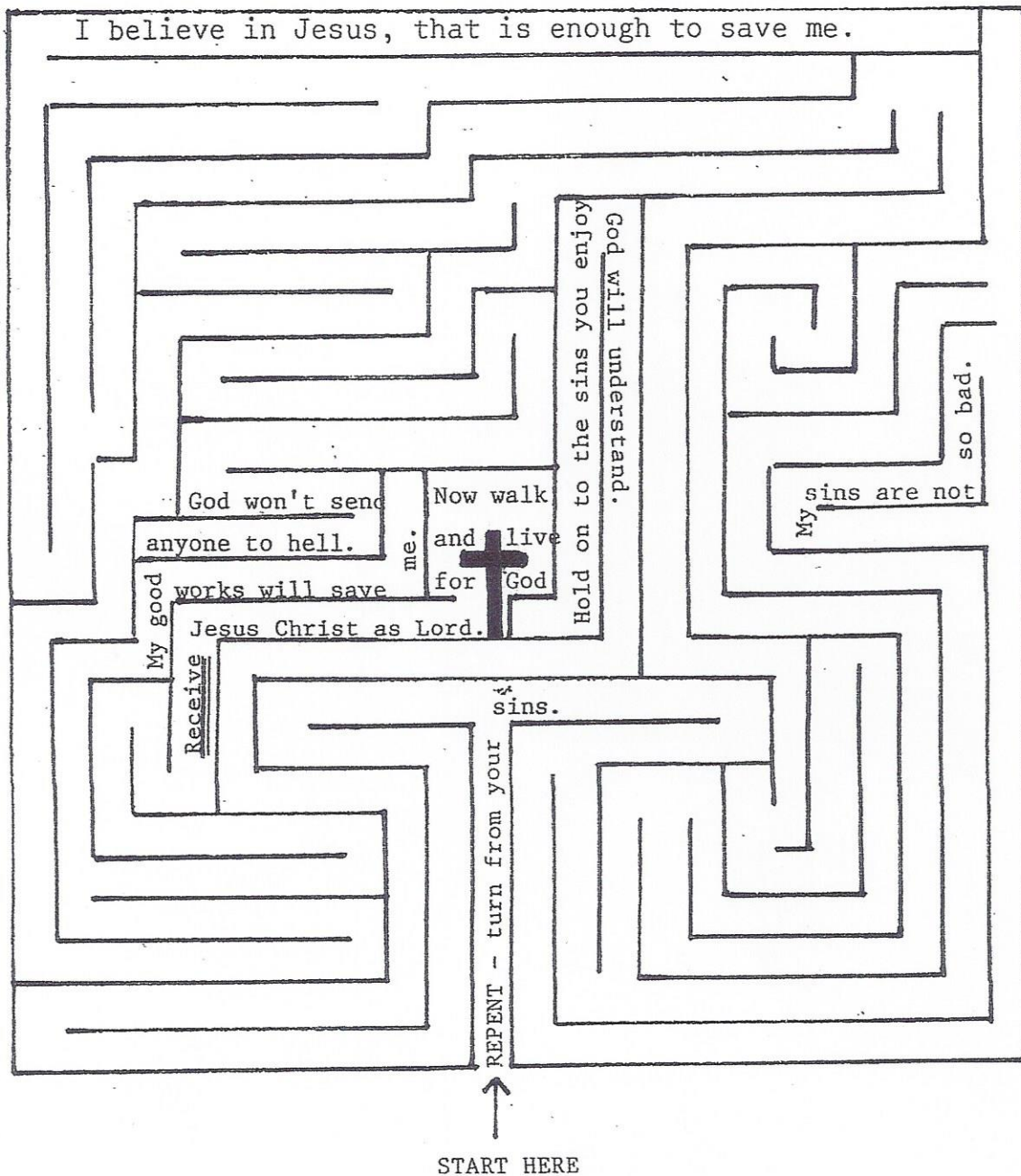
The lame man immediately went home to tell his family and friends. (3:8)

MEMORY VERSE: Thessalonians 2:12



Our memory verse says that we should walk or live worthy of God Who has called us into His kingdom and glory. (1 Thessalonians 2:12) But how do you begin to walk for God? You must be saved by Jesus Christ. What is the first thing you must do to be saved? (Acts 3:19) _____. That means you must turn away from your sins.
