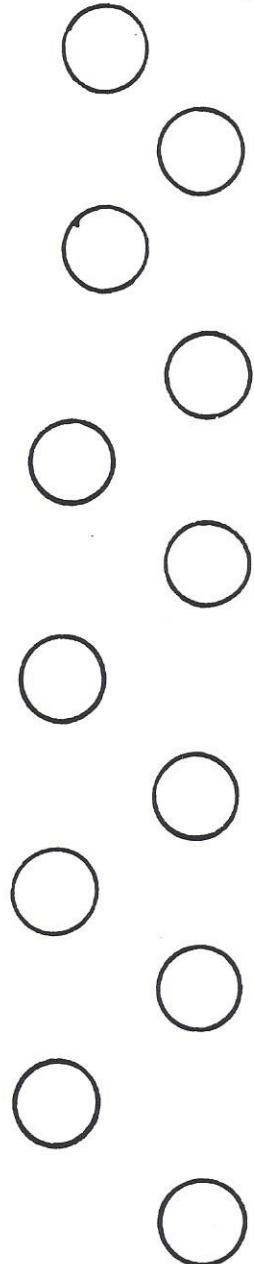
TRUE or FALSE? If the answer is **FALSE**, make the face to look like Bartimaeus' face when he was **BLIND**.



If the answer is **TRUE**, make the face look like Bartimaeus' face when he could see.

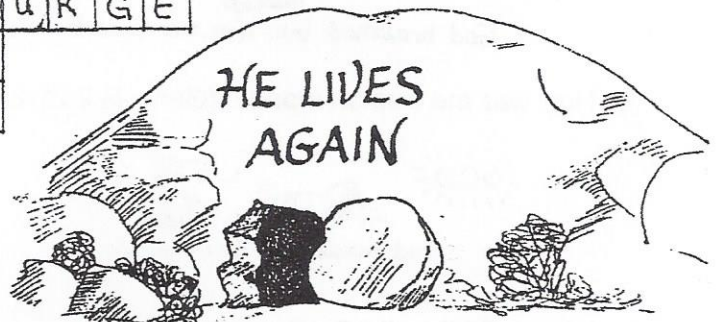
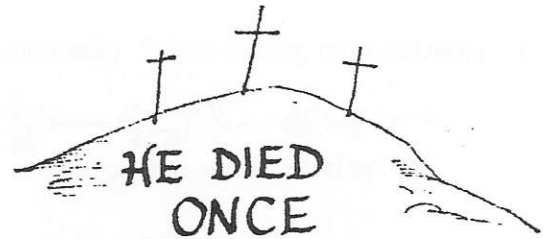
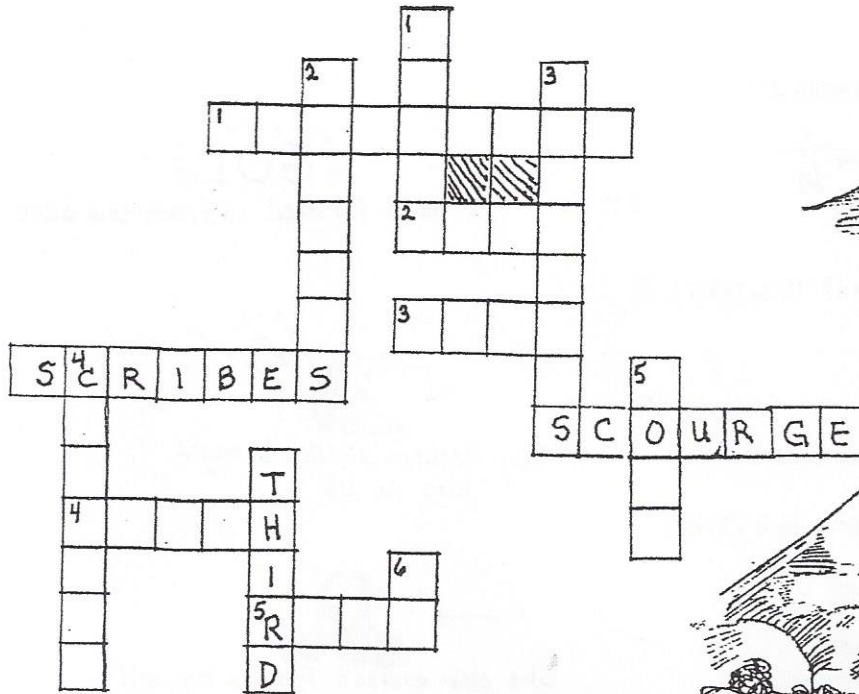


1. Jesus found Bartimaeus in Jerusalem. (10:46)
2. Blind Bartimaeus sat by the highway side begging. (10:46)
3. Bartimaeus heard that Jesus was passing by him and he cried for Jesus to have mercy on him. (10:47)
4. People told Bartimaeus to keep quiet (to hold his peace). (10:48)
5. Bartimaeus was sad, but he kept quiet. (10:48)
6. Jesus stopped and called for Bartimaeus to come to Him. (10:49)
7. Bartimaeus was carried to Jesus by his friends. (10:50)
8. Jesus asked Bartimaeus what it was that he wanted. (10:51)
9. Bartimaeus asked that he might receive his sight. (10:51)
10. Jesus put clay on Bartimaeus' eyes and told him to wash in the pool of Siloam. (10:52)
11. Good works made Bartimaeus whole. (10:52)
12. After Bartimaeus received his sight, he followed Jesus. (10:52)



MEMORY VERSE: Ephesians 2:8

1. The disciples were following 1-D on the way to 1-A. (10:32)
2. There were three groups of men unto whom Jesus was going to be delivered . . . the chief 2-D, the scribes, and finally the 3-D. (10:33)
3. The chief priest and scribes would 4-D Jesus to 4-A. (10:33)
4. The Gentiles would 5-D Jesus, scourge or flog Him, 2-A on Him and 3-A Him. (10:34)
5. On the third day 6-D would 5-A. (10:34)

The only way we can be saved from our sins and be fit to go to heaven is to receive and love Jesus Christ, the One Who suffered and died for our sins and rose again on the third day. Jesus told His disciples that this would happen to Him when He arrived in Jerusalem.
