




DRAW a line from the rule for prayer to the correct scripture verse.

Rules

1. You must be saved by Jesus Christ. (John 14:6)
2. You must pray on your knees. (Mark 11:25)
3. You must pray in Jesus' name. (John 14:13)
4. You must pray alone.
(Acts 4:24)
5. You must believe God will answer.
(Hebrews 11:6)

Rules

6. You must not hold on to any sin. (Psalm 66:18)
7. You must forgive others. (Mark 11:25)
8. You must pray silently. (Acts 4:24)
9. You must pray according to God's will.
(1 Joh 5:14)
10. You should only pray at meal time and bed time.
(I Thessalonians 5:17)
